

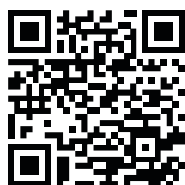

After they get their accreditation, they will be brought to the accommodation facilities.

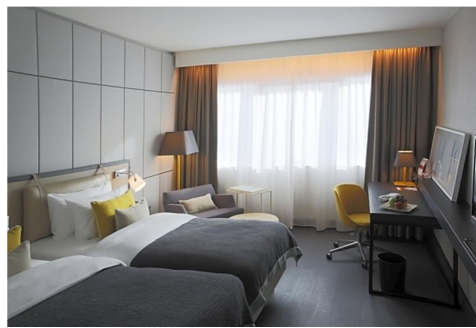

## 8.4. Girls Classification Games

After the group games, the first 2 teams of groups A - C and B - D will be cross games for the 1st - 8th rankings for girls. The winner of these matches will play 1st - 4th position. Losers will play for 5<sup>th</sup> to 8th place. The winners of the games for 1st - 4th place will play the final, and the losers will play the 3rd - 4th place matches.

The winners of the rank games 5th to 8th will play game for the 5th-6th place, and the losers will play the 7th-8th place games. Teams that finished their group in 3rd and 4th place will also complete the championship with cross games in a similar format.

## 8.5. Boys Classification Games

The teams who will play games for the 1st – 8th places will be crossed as follow:

- A1 – C2
- C1 – B3
- B1 – A3
- A2 – B2

The winners of these games will play for the 1st – 4th places, while the losers will play for the 5th – 8th place.

The winners of the games playing for the 1st – 4th will play the final game while the losers will played games for 3rd – 4th places.

The winners of the games for 5th – 8th places will play game for the 5th – 6th places while the losers will play for the 7th – 8th places.

Teams who finished in the last place in groups A, B and C after the group games will play themselves for the 9th - 11th place.



## 8.6. Specific Rules

All matches will be played in accordance with the FIBA rules issued on March 27th 2020 , and valid as of 1st October 2020. Matches will last 4 x 8 minutes, with as many extra periods of 3 minutes as necessary to decide which team wins, with 3 personal fouls, 3 team fouls per quarter and 10 minutes half time interval.

- 🏀 Only the finals for the first place girls and boys will be played according to FIBA regulation, 4 x 10 minutes, 5 minutes' extra time, 4 personal fouls and 4 team fouls per quarter.
- 🏀 Points shall be awarded as follows (qualification games in groups):
  - Win = 2 points
  - Match lost = 1 points

## 10. TRANSPORTATION

All teams will be provided transportation from the airport to the hotels. From the hotels to halls and back. All teams will be provided transportation to Cultural Day and BeTogheter ceremony and back to the hotels.

Teams will not be allowed to stay in the hall after the match, but they must come back to the hotel with shedule bus.

Referees will be transported with the buses with teams by match they were delegated. Transportation timing will be noted every day at the Hotel lobby.

## 11. HEALTH AND SAFETY

The ISF and LOC consider the safety of student athletes and all persons involved as priority. Facing the pandemic of COVID-19, the measures and supervision procedures have been reviewed and adapted to ensure maximum protection.

You can protect yourself and others by knowing the facts and taking the appropriate precautions.

### 11.1. COVID Protocols

- In Serbia, there are no restrictions according to the current rules
- Wearing masks is only mandatory in all medical institutions.

## Protocol in case of infection - COVID 19

Individuals with symptoms and suspected SARS Cov2 should be self-isolated until the results arrive. Upon arrival and confirmed positive SARS Cov 2, that person will have self- isolation for 7 days from the day of testing. Staying in accommodation is allowed in rooms intended for self-isolation. Asymptomatically confirmed cases are treated and behave in accordance with the instructions of the competent medical doctor. In the case of a confirmed positive result for SARS Cov 2, no self-isolation is required for the remaining team members except in the case of symptoms and a positive test for SARS Cov 2.

*\* The costs of self-isolation are borne by the infected delegation person*

## Testing information for departure on Nikola Tesla airport

- A 24/7 facility
- Four hours before flight
- Results available in 60 to 120 minutes
- PCR and antigen testing
- Productive cooperation with public authorities towards the sustainable resumption of air travel

**Belgrade, June 11, 2021** - [A testing center for Covid-19](#) opens at Belgrade Nikola Tesla airport under the management of BELGRADE AIRPORT d.o.o a member of VINCI Airports' network and in cooperation with the Government of Republic of Serbia and the Republic Health Insurance Fund (RHIF). Thanks to the test center, passengers departing and arriving to countries requiring a negative Covid-19 test, as well as all interested citizens and foreign citizens, can now be tested and get results at the airport itself, enabling safer and more efficient travel.

Opened 24 hours a day, the testing center is located at Terminal 1 of Belgrade Airport and provides SARS-CoV-2 virus testing services, as follows:

- Real-Time PCR test, with results available to the user via e-mail within 120 minutes of taking the swab;
- Rapid test on the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus, using rapid antigen tests, with results available to the user via e-mail within maximum 60 minutes of taking the swab;

Test results are issued bilingually, in Serbian and English, and sent to passengers by email. The test center also provides printing services, while access to test results is available only to authorized staff of the competent state institutions. It is important that all passengers are well acquainted with the updated, applicable regulations before traveling to the selected country since each country defines its own rules and requirements for entry and stays on its territory during the pandemic. The price of the tests is equivalent to the level prescribed by the state institutions for such tests in Serbia and amounts to 1,800 RSD for an antigen test and 6,000 RSD for a PCR test.

Payment for testing must be made prior to arriving at the registration point. Payment can also be made at the designated counter of the post office -"Post of Serbia" located on the ground floor of Terminal 1, every day of the week, 00-24h. Registration for testing is conducted at the registration point located near the payment counter or can be conducted electronically, through the official "e-Uprava" portal.

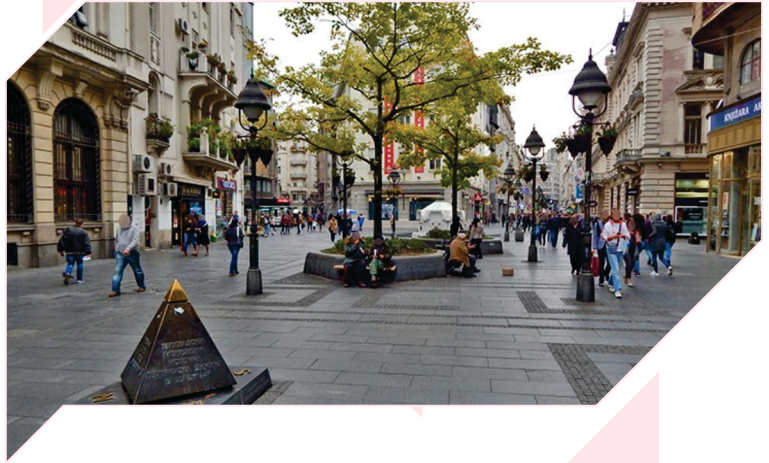

# Welcome to Belgrade

## Knez Mihajlova

*Pedestrian zone and commercial center - Knez Mihailova Street is protected by law since it is one of the oldest and most important monumental urban environments. Knez Mihailova is composed of multiple buildings and representative houses constructed at the end of the 1870s.*



## Skadarlija

*Skadarska Street or Skadarlija, is not boulevard, not an avenue but curving cobblestone alley. It is bohemian and romantic quarter of the Belgrade city sung in many songs and told in many stories. 400 meters long street managed to keep the spirit of old times, authenticity, old look with cobblestone asphalt, identical facade and bars that stand in the same place for more than 150 years.*



## Belgrade Zoo

*Belgrade Zoo is located in the city center at Belgrade's Fortress one of the main historic and tourist attractions of the city. According to some it is a unique zoo in the world, since apart from the numerous rare animals (rarely found in other zoos), this zoo is located within the walls of a city's fortress. Belgrade's Zoo was founded by the Mayor of the city and an industrialist, Vlada Ilic, in 1936.*







## Temple of St. Sava

*It does not matter whether you are an atheist, Catholic, Muslim, Orthodox or belong to another religious group — the Temple of Saint Sava is the symbol of Belgrade and the country.*

*Several religious sites stand out from the rest in spite of strictly defined rules that architects must be met. Unusual proportions and artistic processing, such buildings are beyond religious role and become monuments of great cultural significance.*

## Zemun

*Once a separate town, Zemun has been a municipality within the city of Belgrade since 1945. People have settled the area of Zemun as far back as the Neolithic, using the favourable position of the banks of the Danube and the Sava. The Zemun Fortress is the oldest building in Zemun, mentioned as early as the 9th century. The current remains are from the 15th century.*



## PROTOCOL – COVID 19

Wearing masks is optional.

People with symptoms and suspicion of SARS Cov2 are isolated until test results. Upon arrival of a confirmed positive result for SARS Cov 2, self-isolation for 7 days from the day of testing. Staying in accommodation is allowed in rooms intended for self-isolation.

Asymptomatic confirmed cases are treated and treated in accordance with the instructions of the competent physician. In the case of a confirmed positive result for SARS Cov 2, no self-isolation is required for the remaining team members except in the case of symptoms and a positive test for SARS Cov 2. The cost of testing and self-isolation must be paid by the person with symptoms.
