Participation

- Each participant is required to be present throughout the whole duration of the event, from the day of arrival until the day of departure, specified in the programme in bulletin.
- Each participant is obliged to take part in all of the non-sport activities.
- Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.
- Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.
- The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening, prize-giving-, and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme may result in the disqualification of that team.

Arrivals and departures

Arrivals 13th/14th May

The official ports of entry are the following :

- Charles De Gaulle Airport
- Orly airport
- Gare du Nord (train station)

Driving hours from ports of entries to Deauville are approximately 3 hours. Delegation will be welcomed at the terminal of the airport or of the railway station with the following sign of the ISF by volunteers :

For the delegation who arrive in Paris (airport or train station), the organisation will organise lorry transfert, for the equipment which will not fit in a bus. The equipment will be brought directly to the accomodation facilities.

Delegations arriving to the airport and train station, will be brought directly to the accreditation center (**CID**) to get their accreditation.

Delegations arriving with their own mode of transport (buses, cars, etc.) are expected to arrive directly to the accreditation center, placed in the **CID**, at the following address:

1 Rue Lucien Barrière, 14800 Deauville

After they get their accreditation, they will be brought to the accomodation facilities.

At the arrival of the accomodation, all the delegation (participants, coach, staff...) may have to do an autotest, supervise by a laboratory. Result in 15 minutes (see procedure to follow in case of a positive result, in the appendix)

Please refer to the Appendix for more information on how to enter France safely according to the COVID-19 restrictions implemented by the French government.

**Please note, that the accreditation program after arrivals may be subject to change, depending on the epidemiological situation. Any relevant changes will be communicated to the registered delegations prior to the event.*

To access France each participant would need to fill following document:

- *Engagement sur l'honneur a se soumettre aux regles relatives a l'entree sur le territoire national metropolitain /Undertaking on honour to comply with the rules governing entry into metropolitan France (see appendix)*

Departure 22nd/23rd May

48 hours before departure, all the delegation, need to confirm their departure information to the LOC.

Delegation who need a negative covid test to take their flight or train, will be tested in their accomodation. Delegation need to inform LOC about needs for covid testing 48 hours before departure. The test will be at their own charges. They must pay in advance.

Transportation will be organise to bring all the delegation to the official ports.

Accommodation

Delegations are planned to be accommodated by sports. All accommodation centers are 4* or 5* category. All accommodation will be organized in mobile homes, small houses and studios.

These teams will be reinforced on check in and check out days.

Food and Beverages

Accredited persons will receive 3 meals per day:

- Breakfast
- Lunch
- Dinner

Food will be supplied by private catering companies and will be served as following:

- **Breakfast:** at the accommodation centers, breakfast box to go,
- **Lunch:** on competition sites or locations very close to the competition sites including the CID, Deauville – self-service style or lunch box to go,
- **Dinner:** the CID, Deauville – self-service style – except for the Nation's night,

Water will be provided for all accredited persons during meals.

The LOC will accommodate to specific diet and food restrictions, which will be specified following Phase 2 each participant.

Time of meals will be communicated to the delegations by the board placed in each accommodation welcome center.

Time of meals will be extended; no solution will be offered if participants are not present in restauration points during defined opening time.

No lunch or dinner will be offered in accommodation centers (except isolated persons- covid positive).

Restaurant sites access are reserved to accredited populations.

During the sport activities (training or official competitions), water bottles will always be provided on competition sites.

One snack a day will be distributed to participants during official competitions on competition venues.

Disciplinary Management

Event Disciplinary Commission

In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, The ISF Event Disciplinary Commission shall deal with all incidents and all violations of the ISF Statutes, Sport Policy, ISF Handbook, Rules, and any other ISF document linked to the ISF events and broadly with misbehaviors not directly related to the sport technical regulation during an ISF event.

The Commission is composed of the ISF Delegate, the Sport Committee Chair and LOC Delegate.

Appeal jury

The Appeal Jury shall deal with all protests of a technical sporting nature during the competition. The Appeal Jury is formed for all sports in the ISF Gymnasiade Normandy 2022 and is composed of the Chair of the ISF Technical Commission concerned, one member of the Local Organising Committee, the Head Field of Play Officials.

Anti doping

Doping test will take place during the Event.

ISF being a Wada code signatory is promoting clean sport as one of the main values applied during its events. Besides the tests that can take place accordingly to the age category and the tradition of relevant sports, ISF in cooperation with WADA is implementing a large educational programme to raise awareness on the danger of doping behaviours.

EduC Program

At the crossroad between the formal educational framework and the field of sport, ISF is promoting and organising educational events to set up the proper environment to ensure the skills development of young participants.

Partners and renowned academic speakers for eight days will develop and strengthen the worldwide school sport movement. Combining academic sessions, forum with sports and cultural activities. The educational events are a powerful communication platform for the various school sport communities, where all stakeholders have an opportunity through the different types of events to spend time together and benefit from constructive, quality awareness-raising and learning sessions. This combination gives the ISF events an educational value in the broadest sense of the term for all profile of participants and target groups.

The main goals of the EduC Program are:

- To promote participation of young in sport by encouraging them to engage into physical activity and school sport for a installing a healthy lifestyle;
- To promote and support the use of school sport, through active participation and voluntary activities, as a tool for developing mainstream policies such as gender equality, safeguarding, integrity;
- To create and develop a solid network from national to international levels able to raise awareness among their peers on the importance of school sport as tool for empowerment, and acquiring leadership skills, citizenships behaviour contributing in implementing the sport values and the human rights.

Fun and Skill Zone

Safeguarding in Sport Seminars

Location: In the Centre International Deauville

Date: On May 19th and 20th from 6 to 8 pm.

With leading partners in the field ISF is delivering seminars for the youth and adults on this topic. ISF commitment is based on the fact that "We believe that all children have a right to play sport in an environment where they are safe and their voices can be heard. What is officially recorded regarding children should apply to any stakeholder (volunteer, member, employee, manager...) of our organization. Our focus is on raising awareness regarding safeguarding and ensuring the implementation of the ISF Policy at the field level."

ISF Forum

The ISF Forum offers the opportunity to increase knowledge and understanding about the international school sport movement and to know more about subjects related to education, culture and sport through a series of plenary and panel sessions. Athletes will have the opportunity to visit the sites of the Allied landings on 6th June 1944 -WWII :

The Caen Memorial :

The Caen Memorial Museum is dedicated to the promotion of peace and the memory of soldiers who died for France and freedom. The visit is composed of several animations such as written and video documentaries. Audioguide provided through smartphone app. Capacity : 1600 persons. Travel time : 50'.



The landing beaches :

In the same spirit as the Memorial, all along the Normandy coast, the beaches are full of memories. They witnessed numerous confrontations between the Allied landing forces and the German soldiers. Thus, many museums also litter these beaches. Capacity : no limit. Travel time : Arromanches : 1h15'.



On Saturday 21 May :

Athletes will have the opportunity to visit different cultural sites in Normandy :

- **Le Mont Saint Michel :**

The Mont Saint Michel is a commune, in which stands an abbey named St Michel, surrounded by the Channel Sea. A visit to the mountain is planned in the morning, before having lunch and an afternoon guided tour around Mont Saint Michel. Capacity : 270 persons.

Travel time : 2h15'.



- **Vieux la Romaine :**

Vieux la Romaine is an archaeological site, corresponding to the Gallo-Roman city of Aregenua. It is located in the village of Vieux, 15' south of Caen. After the orienteers' race in the morning in the forest of Grimbosq, an afternoon will be dedicated to the visit of the museum of Vieux la Romaine. The proposed themes are: "Athletes of Olympia, Athletes of today. The visit is translated into English. Capacity : 250 persons. Travel time from CID : 1h. Travel time from Grimbosq : 20'.



- **Le Haras National du Pin :**

The National Stud of Le Pin is the oldest in France. It consists of a castle, stables and a courtyard, named Cour Colbert. A visit of the site is planned in the morning from 10.30 am, before having lunch. A show will be offered in the afternoon before returning to Deauville at 4pm. Capacity : 350 persons. Travel time : 1h30'.



Giverny :

The village of the impressionist Claude Monnet, Giverny is full of flower gardens and pretty stone buildings. A museum dedicated to impressionism can be visited. There will be a visit to the Museum of Impressionism and the gardens. A meal will be provided directly on site. Capacity: not defined. Travel time : 1h40'.



Nations Night

The Nation Night encourage exchanges between the different cultures of the participating countries. During the Nation Night, each delegation is entitled to have a booth to present themselves, in a fair atmosphere. Delegations are free to bring any material for presenting themselves over the booth.

The Nation Night is set to be on the 18th May , in the CID in Deauville from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Important information: it will not be possible to bring food, animals or plants during this nation Night. On the other hand, you will be able to come with crafts, culture and floklore of your country.

Finally, Nations who so wish will be able to go on stage to present a typical dance of their country. If nations want to take part in this animation, please report to the LOC (service to delegations) And provide music in MP3 format by naming the file "nalmeofcountry.songtitle.MP3"

The Accreditation Center will be located in the Centre International de Deauville (CID).

For all delegations, accreditation released will be done at the CID before joining the accommodation centers.

- **The accreditation center will be open all day long on May 13th and May 14th**
- All delegations, coming either with their own means of transport or with the LOC's means of transport from the airport, are expected to arrive directly at the CID to be accredited: **1 Rue Lucien Barrière, 14800 Deauville**
- An identification document must be presented to get the accreditations
- A temporary identification system will be put in place in case the normative accreditations need to be changed
- Accreditations will be issued by sport, by delegation, and by function

At the Accreditation Center, the Head of Delegation must be present. He/she can be accompanied by a coach or by an additional adult. No other member of the delegation shall be admitted to the accreditation room.

At accreditation, the following ***documents** will be checked:

1. **Valid ID/passport:** The passport (or ID card) bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth for each member of the delegation. Please note that copies or scans of the ID/passports will not be accepted
2. **Proof of payment:** proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges. To help the ISF to correctly process your payment, please complete the "payment overview" form and send it to the ISF by e-mail prior to your arrival on the event.

A scan of the below mentioned documents will have to be uploaded on ISF server through the link that have been sent out to your e-mail with instruction

1. **ISF Consent Form:** the use of image and anti-doping consent form of each participant, signed by the competitor's parent or legal guardian if he/she is a minor.
2. **ISF School Certificate:** the ISF School Certificate form signed by the legitimate School Sport Entity, confirming that all athletes are full time students in school since the beginning of the school year.
3. **Insurance:** the document certifying that the delegation is covered by an insurance. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.
4. **Payment Overview:** proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges. Payment Overview will be available soon

Registered countries will be informed on when and how to deliver proof of payment documents

Accreditations cards will be handed to the Head of Delegation at the end of the process, once all documents have been checked.

Please note, that the accreditation process may be subject to change. Any relevant changes will be communicated to the registering delegation prior to the event.

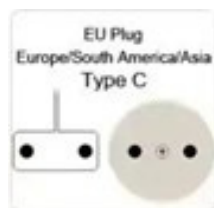
